He insisted to make Case Studies, Assignments and Internships as mandatory. He also mentioned that internship should not be a burden for students. It should be designed according to the capability of the students and it may be arranged in and around the college environment.

Dr. Bhakeel Ahmed, Senior Joint Secretary suggested that research internships should also be included.

Dr. T. Bina, suggested that BCom Fin Tech Syllabus to be framed with more technological concepts, such as Python, Data Analytics, Digital Banking, Micro Internships should be arranged for students to meet the micro entrepreneur in their surroundings. He further added that the students should be encouraged to subscribe the online internship for better understanding of the concepts.

Dr. A. G. V. Narayanan suggested that sincere efforts were important to achieve greater things. Hence the faculty members should be well equipped and updated in industry relations which will help in framing new programmes. He also said that more focus should be given on FDP with budget allocation.

Dr. Ayub Khan Dawood suggested to revamp the syllabus of BCom (Hons) to integrate ACCA, more MNCs and Overseas opportunities and to have more subject papers in the place of language papers for specialised programmes as done in many colleges and to carry out these revamping of the syllabi B.Com Fin Tech & BCom (Hons) and will be sent for ratification to the Academic Council Members within in a month.
