* As per the G.O. of UGC, there is a condition for minimum requirement for online programme. With the approval of UGC, Certificate programmes may be offered online. There will be no problem in teaching the regular programmes online.

* In future only degree programmes will be valid than

Certificate programme.

- * These programmes may be offered under skill development with more emphasis on training with effective laboratory exposure.
- * It was recommended for all the departments to offer such programmes.
- * UGC norms to be thoroughly verified

Mr A. Charles, Associate Professor, Department of Computer Science, St. Joseph's College, Trichy

- * Suggested that being an autonomous College, our College can offer Certificate, Diploma and Advanced Diploma courses online and not degree programmes.
- * The faculty members handling such courses should be well trained on e-content, teaching and interaction methods. Professionals also may be engaged.

Mr. B. Krishnan AVP- Content & Curriculum Synergists EdTech Bengaluru, Karnataka

- * Suggested to offer skill development courses, after defining whether the learning is synchronous or asynchronous.
- * Referred the Courses in World Class Skill Centres via Entrepreneurship. With UGC Approval, it could help the institution to offer the same.

Mr. Jagannadan Murali Chartered Accountant, Partner at J. Murali & Co, Chennai.

- * Suggested to offer online Programmes related to accounting. Dr. AEGC RAJANI responded that Certificate Course in Tally with GST is been offered for non-Commerce students.
- * Expressed about the 10 day programme (Weekly 3 hours) GST Certificate (Skill Based Training and Testing Programme) offered by Bharathiyar University, Coimbatore sponsored by the Central Govt. Pvt. Institutions also may offer if they satisfy the expected norms.
- * A programme may be offered on Income Tax that would be benefit advance learners.

Resolution 3

- * Equivalent papers are not necessary to repeat, though it is difficult to compare and give equivalency.
- * To Check whether other colleges are following the same.
- * Marks may be normalized instead of asking them to write all the papers again.

Suggested

- * Equivalent major papers studied should be considered
- * The students from parent university boundary atleast may be permitted to avail equivalency. And if the students are from other universities, the new rule may be applied.
